LAVENDER

This Month at Danai, We plant small Lavender Plants. They best grow in a pot

Planting lavender in a pot will allow you to have a little bit more control over the environment it's in.

- Make sure the pot has holes and is raised off the ground slightly.
- Give your plants plenty of space..
- You'll have to keep a closer eye on their water needs. Potted plants dry out faster than those in the ground.

When watering, Lavender like some sand

- Add sand to the soil it's growing in. The sand will help water pass through the area the roots are in faster. (Do this before you plant your lavender.)
- If you lose a plant due to overwatering remove all the soil in that spot and replace it before you put another plant in. Not only to help fight funguses that got in but also to give your next lavender a better chance at life.
